2) New Session: Our school saw its opening for the academic year 2024-25 on 5th April 2024. The staff along with the management welcomed the students and their parents.

Our committed staff of is undergoing up process of continuous development by undertaking a number of training sessions on different portals of CBSE. Eager to accept the challenges of teaching , the teachers have quickly learnt the different teaching methods and way of keeping students actively involved in different creative activities.

5) Rashtriya Potion Maah:

Potion maah is celebrated in the month of September to ensure community mobilization people's participation. In the year 2021, as India celebrates **Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav**, this month has been subdivided into weekly themes with a focused assimilated approach to improve holistic nutrition.

The 1st theme is plantation activity as potion vatika and was observed from September 1st to September 7th. The 2nd theme was **Yoga and Ayush** food nutrition and was observed from September 8th to September 15th.

6.3) Shiksha Saptah: Shiksha Saptah(July 22-28, 2024) is commemorating the 4th anniversary of N.E.P 2020. The weeklong celebration provides and excellent opportunity to reflect on the transformative reform introduced by N.E.P.

Day 4: Cultural Day: Activities: Giddha, patriotic dance, folk music, saraswati vandna and different ragas.

Day 5: Skill- Based education: Activities: Document file in M.S word, online chatting HTML, morphing in Photoshop, online shopping, java programming.

Day 6: Eco day: Activities: tree plantation drive and sapling distribution.

Day 7: Community involvement day: Activities: Slogan writing and educational workshop by our volunteer (Kiran Ma'am) T.G.T on nutritional support for children.

6.4) National Nutrition Week: It is celebrated every year September 1 to September 7, to raise awareness about the importance of nutrition and healthy eating habits. Our young chefs from grade 1 to 3 decorate salad and make sprouts. Students from 4th to 8th made healthy diet chart and brought different healthy lunch box. A seminar was also organized for senior classes, in which we discussed harmful effect of junk food and raise awareness about healthy eating habits.

6.5 Veer Gatha 4.0 : The aim of the project is to disseminate the details of the acts of bravery of the Gallantry Awardees and the life stories of these brave hearts among the students to raise the spirit of patriotism. Students of grade 3rd to 8th wrote poem, 9th to 10th made painting and 11th to 12th wrote essay on Gallantry Award winners.

6.5 (A) Road Safety: The day is celebrated in school to raise awareness among students about the importance of road safety. A quiz was organized for 4th to 7th, declamation activity was for class 8th, students of 9th and 11th wrote essay and students of 10th and 12th made poster on road safety.
