2) New Session: Our school saw its opening for the academic year 2025-26 on 1st April 2025. The staff along with the management welcomed the students and their parents.

3) Academic Excellence: “Excellence is an art won by training and habituation. The system of education in our school, is a blend of theory and practice in the right proportion to arrive at a comprehensive curriculum.

4) Teacher enhancement programs: “It’s the teacher that makes the change, not the mere classroom.

Our committed staff of is undergoing up process of continuous development by undertaking a number of training sessions on different portals of CBSE. Eager to accept the challenges of teaching , the teachers have quickly learnt the different teaching methods and way of keeping students actively involved in different creative activities.

5) Rashtriya Poshan Maah:

Poshan maah is celebrated in the month of September to ensure community mobilization and people's participation. In the year 2025, as India celebrates, this month themed as Swasth Nari Swasth Parivaar from 17th September to 16th October .

The month has been subdivided into weekly themes with a focused and assimilated approach to improve holistic nutrition.

This 8th poshan maah focused on six key themes-Mindful Eating, Childhood Care and Education ,Nutrition Behaviour for Infants and Young Children ,Men's Participation ,Vocal for Local and Convergence and Digitalization.

6.1) Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat: The initiative **Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat** was announced by honourable Prime Minister on 31st October 2015 on the occasion of 140th birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabh bhai Patel.

This program aims to enhance interaction and promote mutual understanding between people of different states/ UT through the concept of state/ UT's pairing. Haryana and Telangana have become partner state under this program.

6.2) Art integrated learning: It is a teaching learning model which is based on learning through the arts and with the art. It is the process where art become the medium of teaching – learning, a key to understanding concepts within any subject of the curriculum. It is a framework of experiential learning which provides an equitable learning environment for all learners through their own access points.

6.3) National Nutrition Week: It is celebrated every year September 1 to September 7, to raise awareness about the importance of nutrition and healthy eating habits. Our young students from grade 3rd to 5th participated in Healthy Plate . Students from 4th to 8th made Healthy Diet Chart . A seminar was also organized for senior classes, in which we discussed harmful effect of junk food and raise awareness about healthy eating habits.

6.5 Veer Gatha 4.0 : The aim of the project is to disseminate the details of the acts of bravery of the Gallantry Awardees and the life stories of these brave hearts among the students to raise

the spirit of patriotism. Students of grade 3rd to 8th wrote poem, 9th to 10th made painting and 11th to 12th wrote essay on Gallantry Award winners.

6.5 (A) Road Safety: The day is celebrated in school to raise awareness among students about the importance of road safety. The day was celebrated on 15th October, 2025. There was an Inter School Road Safety Quiz Competition in our school at three levels. Level 1: Class 3rd to 5th, Level 2: Class 6th to 8th, Level 3: Class 9th to 12th

6.6 Deworming Program: Our school is committed to ensuring the health and wellbeing of our students. As part of this effort, we will be conducting a Deworming program on 26th August. All students from 1st to 12th standard will be administered albendazole tablets to prevent worm infection.

6.7) Vigilance Awareness Week: The vigilance awareness week is celebrated every year in the birthday week of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, often referred to as the “**Bismark of India**”.

It was celebrated from 27th October to 2nd November 2025 with great enthusiasm and active participation. The main purpose was to encourage stakeholders to collectively participate in the fight against corruption. Our kick started the week with an oath ceremony on 29th October in assembly to fight against corruption. Senior students conveyed their message through cartoon strips and gave a message that transparency and ethics are essential in society.

6.8) 26 November 2024 Constitution Day: The day marks the adoption of the Indian constitution by the constituent assembly. To celebrate the day the school organized different activities, *a thought-provoking skit depicting the making of the constitution and highlighting the significance of Fundamental Rights and Duties* was shown to students to raise awareness and significance of the constitution. Students of different grades participated in a quiz and speech competition on the constitution to understand the importance of our constitution.
